2 CONSIDER ACKERMAN CSD REQUEST FOR ALLOCATION OF FUNDING

4. CONSIDER DECLARING COLL-O-CRIMP TOOL SURPLUS

The board shall consider declaring a Dana Coll-O-Crimp Portable T460 and accessories surplus. The Agency need for crimping hydraulic hoses has declined over time. The tool has not been used in over 15 years. The few specialty hoses for A/C systems are sourced from local businesses.

The value of the Collar-O-Crimp and accessories is less than \$1,000, if a buyer can be located. Agency staff recommends disposal to free up space in the shop.

Mr. Ward will present the Agency Report. None of the trainees from the summer have been hired by the Agency. Two did not complete training. Trainees from the August class may be available to driver starting in late November potentially allowing some routes to be brought back in January 2023.
