### **Old Business:**

#### **Membership and Member Books:**

Rhonda McLeary asked everyone to check the current 2026 book for any corrections and report back to her with the changes. Laurie Grant reminded everyone we do need new members, so, if you have a friend or know of someone wanting to golf, bring them as a guest or get their information to Rhonda.

#### **Sunshine:**

Cindi Henning volunteered to assist Laurie Gannon with the sunshine committee. She reminded everyone if they know of someone who is ill, or having a rough go of it and needs cheering up, let Laurie or Cindy know so they can get a card out to them.

#### **Beautification:**

Linda Hardman will continue to represent our league at the RCSC Greens Committee. She reported the RCSC are looking for and have a need for 35 more marshals. They must work a minimum of 8 hours a month. They receive a \$2 golf round for every 4 hours worked.

She also reported the following closure schedule for golf course maintenance at Willowbrook.

Verti cutting on April 16<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup>;

Aerating - June 8<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>

Overseeding – September 28<sup>th</sup> – October 17<sup>th</sup>

Cart path only until November 17<sup>th</sup>

Her last item was a request for ideas to beautify Willowbrook Golf course, such as new plants, trees, flowers etc. She asked for suggestion to be emailed to her by April 2<sup>nd</sup>. Some suggestions offered were no flowers because of the care required, but, metal floral displays at various placed would be nice.

She was also asked to report to the green committee the observation of the maintenance crews “doing donuts in the rough” while mowing and other various inappropriate maneuvers. In addition to that, a request to train the workers to not interfere with golfers, such as mowing on the edge of the greens while golfers are putting, mowing the greens, while golfers are on the tee box and mowing the tee box while golfers are teeing off.. And lastly, relocating the 150-yard marker on hole #10 to either a painted line on the cart path, or the pole to the opposite side of the fairway as to not interfere with golfers teeing off on the yellow tees.

**Rules:**

Sue Swanson will continue to be the Rules Chairman, and she explained the new rule regarding the concrete canals. If your ball comes to rest in or on the concrete water canals or bridges it is considered to be in a penalty area. However, if the ball is in the general playing area of the course and the canal or bridge interferes with your normal swing or stance, free relief shall be given. Relief shall not be given for line-of-sight interference. She also reminded the members; the 1<sup>st</sup> group out should align the tee box as necessary.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Cindy Henning brought up the possibility of creating a “hole in one” pot in addition to the budgeted \$75.00 for a hole in one. After much discussion about the pros and cons, the decision was made to table the idea until the fall.

Laurie Grant then presented Rhonda McLeary, Sue Reisinger, Pat Nunemaker and Cindi Finken with a plant as a thank you for helping her during the league year.

Pat presented Laurie with a gift from the board for her work and leadership during the league year.

Laurie then presented the awards to all the tournament winners as well as Most Improved Golfers: Every member that participated for a minimum of 2 days of the tournament was awarded a prize in the form of cash and certs or cash.

The most improved golfer for the Red Tees went to Sherri Wilkes.

The most improved golfer for the Yellow Tees went to Sue Swanson.

Each received a framed certificate.

The Club Champion award went to Cindi Finken.

After the awards were presented Cindy Henning motioned the meeting be adjourned and Pat Nunemaker made the second. The meeting was then adjourned and the members enjoyed a taco bar presented by Laurie and Steve Grant.
