President Laurie Grant called the meeting to order.

The minutes for the March 25th meeting were available for corrections with none reported. Sue Reisinger read the treasury report and it was reported we have a balance of \$264.18

Old Business:

As approved in the November 2024 meeting, the dues for the 2026 year will be \$60.00 for all members including those with GHIN handicaps at another club. Included in this membership fee is: GHIN Handicaps, Web Site fees, Birdie Pins, Tournaments, Member book and Petty Cash.

Yellow Tees:

At this time, the yellow tees have not been sanctioned by USGA/GHIN. Until that time, for league play, we will use the Red Tees. Linda Hardman will address this with the Green's Committee for further status and information.

Fun Day:

The last play day of the month will continue to be a Fun Day/Team Play format. Pat Nunemaker will be responsible for the format. We will continue to have the 50/50 raffle on that day.

Membership and Member Books:

Rhonda McLeary passed around the Membership Books for corrections and the addition of the members birthday.

The guest policy was revisited. Currently a guest may play twice while deciding to join our league. In the past, exceptions were made as there was room on the tee sheet, however, it was brought to our attention that because we are given a block of tee times, letting guests play more than the allotted twice can impact our ability to receive our preferential tee times, therefore we can no longer make exceptions.

In order to become a league member, a RCSC rec number is a requirement. If a non-resident of Sun City wishes to join, they must purchase the non-resident golf membership and obtain a RCSC rec number.

The members were reminded the dues for the coming year are due no later than Tuesday, December 2nd.

Handicaps:

The maximum score a member can record on a hole is dictated by their handicap and the hole rating. In order to be accurate and fair with each member, it requires entering the score hole by hole. (The handicap system then makes the appropriate adjustment). Because of the added workload, the board has agreed to take on that responsibility. Laurie Grant submits the scores when she is Sun City, and Sue Reisinger, Pat Nunemaker and Cindi Finken will submit them in her absence. Sue Resinger will be the contact person on record. Laurie Grant thanked Laurie Gannon for her hard work in getting the GHIN system set up and running.

Bulletin Boards:

Over the summer, a group of volunteers (Donna, Sue, Edie, Cindi) cleaned up, painted and washed the glass on the two bulletin boards assigned to our league. The boards will be updated as necessary.

Chip Ins:

We will continue to do the chip ins at each POD including the Fun Day with Bev Pedersen as the primary and Pat Nunemaker as her back up.

Sunshine:

Bev Pedersen and Laurie Gannon will head up the Sunshine committee and each member is asked to inform them of any known situation so they can respond on behalf of the club.

Beautification:

Linda Hardman will continue to represent our league at the RCSC Greens Committee. She reported there were concerns about the greens on Willowbrook vs Willowcreek. She was advised the reason there is such a difference is the greens are cut at "10" making them slower to accommodate the notion that more beginners play on Willowbrook. She also reported that light weight rakes for the bunkers and light weight 100/150 yard markers are coming.

It was asked if she would report that on holes where there are no yellow tee markers, the yellow marker be placed with the red tee marker, as it is done at other courses.

Linda asked the members to share concerns with her so she can address them at the Greens Committee meetings.

Rules:

Sue Swanson will continue to be the rules chairwomen. The issue of large clumps of grass left, after mowing, in the rough/fairway with the ball coming to rest on top of it was addressed. As a result, a discussion was held about the "lift/clean/place" rule and whether or not that could be used. Rhonda McLeary moved the lift/clean/place (lift/sweep/place) rule be adopted during all league play days. Pam Prosser 2nd the motion and it carried. This will become a league rule.

POD and Tee Sheets:

Pam explained the process of determining who wins the POD in the event of a tie. Currently, the tie was broken by comparing the score of each player based on full 18 hole by hole rating (Score-card playoff). However, If the POD did not include that specific hole, if didn't seem fair to include that in the score card playoff. Cindy Henning moved the scorecard playoff reflect only the holes used on that day's POD format. Pat Nunemaker 2nd the motion and the motion carried. Pam will now use only the holes used on that day's POD format.

Important Dates:

Currently the "End of Year" luncheon was set for December 8th (the 2nd Tuesday in December). Because of a conflict with the Lady Lynx Thursday Club of which many of our members belong, Sue Swanson suggested we move the date to January. During the discussion it was noted that many members are not in Sun City during the holidays and we would be able to accommodate more by moving the date to January. Cindi Finken moved we change the date to the 1st Monday in January (the exception would be if Jan 1 falls on the 1st Monday of January, then the luncheon would move 1 week later). Sue Swanson 2nd the motion and the motion was approved. This year's luncheon will now be **January 5th**.

Rhonda brought up a "Pink Ribbon Tournament" to be held at Quail Run on December 4th. If anyone is interested in playing, let Rhonda know asap.

As there was no further business, Pan Nunemaker moved the meeting be adjourned, Pam Prosser 2nd the motion and at 13:40 PM the meeting was adjourned.
