PARENTS MAY CONTACT A STAFF MEMBER IF THEY ARE SIMPLY RUNNING LATE FOR CLASS OR WILL BE ABSENT.

STUDENT/PARENT CONDUCT: PHYSICAL, MENTAL, EMOTIONAL OR CYBER BULLYING BY STUDENTS, STAFF OR PARENTS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND MAY RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM THE STUDIO. WE TAKE THIS VERY SERIOUSLY!

DROP OFF/PICK UP: PLEASE DO NOT DROP OFF YOUR CHILD MORE THAN 10 MINUTES BEFORE THEIR SCHEDULED CLASS TIME. PLEASE BE PROMPT WITH PICK UP - IF MORE THAN 10 MINUTES LATE A \$10 CHARGE WILL BE ADDED TO YOUR ACCOUNT SO THAT WE CAN PAY OUR FACULTY THE ADDITIONAL TIME THEY SPENT AT THE STUDIO WORKING OUTSIDE OF THEIR SCHEDULED CLASSES. PICK UP AND DROP OFF IS AVAILABLE AT THE BACK OF THE BUILDING AS WELL. PLEASE EMAIL OR TEXT US IF YOU WOULD LIKE THIS OPTION!

DRESS

TWIRLING TODDLERS: BALLET ATTIRE NOT REQUIRED FOR THIS CLASS. ANY CLOTHES THAT CHILD CAN FREELY MOVE IN IS ACCEPTABLE.

BALLET/TAP COMBO: PINK OR SKIN TONE COLORED TIGHTS.
ANY COLORED LEOTARD WITH OR WITHOUT SKIRT. PINK OR
SKIN TONE LEATHER FULL SOLE BALLET SHOE. BLACK
PATENT LEATHER TAP SHOE. HAIR SECURED OUT OF FACE

BALLET IA: PINK OR SKIN TONE TIGHTS AND SPLIT SOLE LEATHER BALLET SHOE. SOLID BLACK OR PINK LEOTARD. SOLID BLACK OR PINK PULL ON SKIRT (OPTIONAL). HAIR SECURED OUT OF FACE.

BALLET IB: PINK OR SKIN TONE TRANSITION TIGHTS AND SPLIT SOLE CANVAS BALLET SHOE, SOLID BLACK LEOTARD, NO SKIRTS. HAIR IN A BUN



BALLET II: PINK OR SKIN TONE TRANSITION TIGHTS. SOLID BLACK LEOTARD, NO SKIRTS. PINK OR SKIN TONE SPLIT SOLE LEATHER OR CANVAS BALLET SHOE. MEDIUM STRENGTH THERABAND. HAIR MUST BE IN BUN.

BALLET III: PINK OR SKIN TONE TRANSITION TIGHTS. BLACK LEOTARD. NO SKIRTS. CANVAS SPLIT SOLE BALLET SHOE. HARD STRENGTH THERABAND. HAIR MUST BE IN BUN.

BALLET IV: PINK OR SKIN TONE TRANSITION TIGHTS. ANY COLORED LEOTARD. CANVAS SPLIT SOLE BALLET SHOE. HARD STRENGTH THERABAND. HAIR MUST BE IN BUN.

JAZZ: ANY COLORED LEOTARD. BIKE SHORTS, LEGGINGS, OR TIGHTS. TAN LEATHER JAZZ SHOE. HAIR SECURED OUT OF FACE.

LYRICAL: ANY COLORED LECTARD, BIKE SHORTS, LEGGINGS, OR TIGHTS. NUDE OR SKIN TONE LEATHER HALF SHOE. HAIR SECURED OUT OF FACE

TAP: ANY COLORED LEOTARD, BIKE SHORTS, LEGGINGS, TIGHTS, OR FITTED SHIRT. BLACK LACE UP TAP SHOE. HAIR SECURED OUT OF FACE

ACRO: LEOTARD AND SHORTS/LEGGINGS PREFERRED. ANY TIGHT FITTING ATHLETIC CLOTHES ACCEPTABLE. NO LOOSE T-SHIRTS OR TANK TOPS. HAIR MUST BE SECURED UP.




