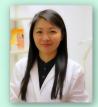

Evidence Based Fertility Acupuncture is Safe and Effective

Acupuncture Has Been Treating Women's Health Concerns for Thousands of Years!

Acupuncture has become well known as a treatment for various types of pain, but many people still don't know that acupuncture has been used for thousands of years to treat a wide variety of health conditions. Traditional Chinese Medicine has always observed the importance of a woman's menstrual cycle as an indicator of her overall health. Acupuncture can be helpful with:

- Amenorrhea
- Irregular periods
- Painful periods
- Heavy bleeding
- PMS



Acupuncture in Support of In-vitro Fertilization Treatment (IVF)

Since the late 1990s, there has been a growing body of evidence that acupuncture can safely complement IVF treatment. Research has shown (Hullender, 2019) that combining the two together can effectively increase:

- Clinical Pregnancy Rate (CPR) by 28-32%
- Ongoing Pregnancy Rate (OPR) by 42%
- Live Birth Rate (LBR) by 30%
- CPR by 60% and LBR by 42% in women with previously failed IVF cycles

Before, During and After Care

Getting regular acupuncture treatment during the weeks leading up to conception is important. Maintaining treatment during pregnancy and after birth is equally as important. Acupuncture is safe during gestation and can help with:

- Moring sickness
- Anxiety
- Low back pain

After Birth Acupuncture Can Help with:

- Post-partum depression
- Fatigue
- Insufficient lactation
- Mastitis
