Maryland Handgun Qualification License (HQL)

- 1. Confirm eligibility:
 - Be at least 21 years old
 - · Be a resident of Maryland
 - Not be prohibited by federal or state law from purchasing or possessing a handgun
- 2. Complete required training:
 - Enroll in a 4-hour firearms safety training course approved by the Secretary
 - Course must include instruction on state firearm law, home firearm safety, and handgun mechanisms and operation
 - Must demonstrate safe operation and handling of a firearm
- 3. Get fingerprinted:
 - Obtain fingerprints at a Livescan Fingerprinting service provider
 - Keep the fingerprint receipt for your application
- 4. Prepare for application:
 - Have a valid government-issued photo ID ready
 - Gather your training completion certificate
- 5. Submit application ED | CONFIDENT | PREPARED
 - Access the Maryland State Police Licensing Portal
 - Choose "Firearms Services" under PROFESSION
 - Select appropriate LICENSE TYPE (e.g., HQL Standard, HQL Training Exempt)
 - Complete the online application form
 - Upload required documents
 - Pay the application fee
- 6. Application processing:
 - The Maryland State Police will review your application
 - This process can take up to 30 days
- 7. Receive HQL:
 - Once approved, you'll receive an email notification
 - Your HQL will be mailed to the address on file
