This term alone, the Kingfishers Charity Fund has been able to support 7 children specifically with complex SEN needs, 2 Looked After Children, and a full cohort of Year 6 pupil premium children at the Holt Farm Primary School who couldn't yet swim the required 25m at the end of KS2. We have paid for these children attending Holt Farm to have 6 hours of lessons per child and have also provided full funding for the pool hire and teaching staff thanks to the money previously raised. 11 children attended this half term with the remaining children attending in January.
