- Follow all traffic laws, campground policies, and safety protocols (e.g., no distractions, seatbelt enforcement).
- Log trips, passenger counts, or incidents as required.
- Be punctual and ready for daily 8 AM starts, working through the 1 PM end time.

- Reliable, punctual, and comfortable driving in rural/Missouri road conditions

- Friendly and patient demeanor—great with families, groups, and tourists!

- Prior shuttle, van, or passenger transport experience a plus (e.g., tourism, hotel, airport shuttles), but not required—we'll train on routes.
