

Preliminary Town Budget increase estimates were presented by the BOE at 6.4% and BOS at 4.2%. BOF has requested new proposals for discussion at the April BOF meeting reflecting a 5.0% BOE increase and a 3.8% BOS increase.

Several Capital Requests were made and will be brought to Public Meeting for Vote on Thursday, March 5th, 7:00pm at the Mary Ellen Brown Senior Community Center including a new Senior Center Bus, Granbrook Park playscape renovations and Emergency Services equipment. Solar parking canopies may be installed beginning this spring at the Mary Ellen Brown Senior/Community Center, the EGHS Upper and Lower Parking Lot and the EGMS Parking Lot. The installation will result in \$50K/year electricity credit each to the BOE and Town Campus for twenty years. It'll also decrease costs to clear snow from buses and police vehicles.

First Selectperson Hayes is forming an Agricultural Impact Commission to provide East Granby farming families an official voice in protecting their farmlands and to offer advice and concerns to the Planning and Zoning Commission and Conservation Commissions.
