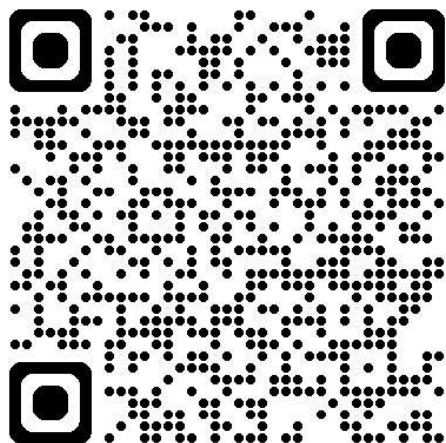

Day 1: Thursday, December 2, 2027 Overnight Flight Your cultural experience of a lifetime begins with an overnight flight to Prague.

Day 2: Friday, December 3, 2027 Prague, Czech Republic Arrive in Prague, the cultural capital of Bohemia. Upon arrival, settle into the hotel and join your Tour Manager on an orientation walk of the city.

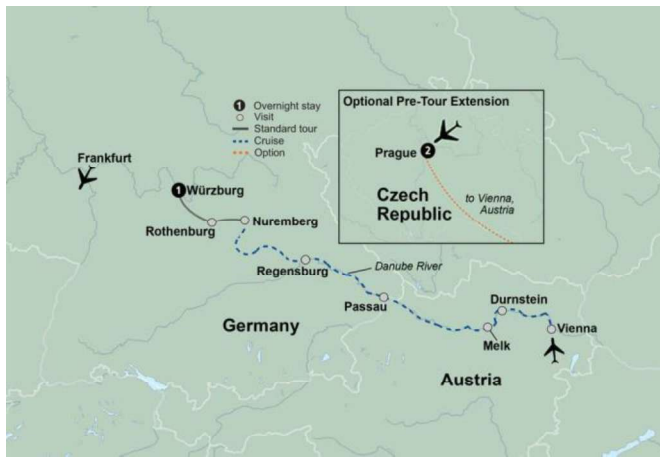
Day 3: Saturday, December 4, 2027 Prague Your day in this fairytale city begins with a panoramic tour through Prague, before arriving at Hradcany Castle,* where you'll join a guided tour followed by a stroll towards the Old Town Square. Visit the beautiful St. Vitus Cathedral and see the iconic statue-lined Charles Bridge. After you've toured the city, it's time to explore the magical Christmas markets of Prague. Wander the stalls filled with hearty food, soul-warming mulled wine, and handmade crafts and ornaments. (B)

Day 4: Sunday, December 5, 2027 Prague - Vienna, Austria Your time in Prague ends today. You'll be transferred to your ship where you'll experience the beauty of Christmas on the Danube. Your tour opens today in Vienna, Austria's capital city. You may relax in the ship's lounge and enjoy refreshments until your cabin is ready in the late afternoon. You may also consider visiting Vienna's Christmas markets.* Tonight, gather with your fellow travelers and celebrate the journey ahead with a welcome dinner on board your ship. (B, D)

Day 5: Monday, December 6, 2027 Vienna It is time to step off the ship and explore. After walking along the pier to reach your coach, join a local expert on a panoramic city tour and see Vienna's architecture, including Hofburg Palace, the Vienna Opera House, and the Ringstrasse. Then, discover the city on foot as you walk through its charming cobblestone streets towards the awe-inspiring St. Stephen's Cathedral and festive Christmas market. The afternoon is yours. Perhaps you'll join an optional excursion to Schönbrunn Palace, the Habsburgs' summer retreat, to enjoy its festive atmosphere and courtyard Christmas market. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Tuesday, December 7, 2027 Wachau Valley - Dürnstein - Melk Spend the morning visiting the medieval cobblestone streets of Dürnstein, a town crowned by the remnants of a castle tied to Richard the Lionheart's legend. Enjoy some time to explore the charms and character of this centuries-old town. Then, get a taste of local tradition at a Glühwein party before returning onboard. Relax as you journey through the Wachau Valley, admiring the scenery dotted with castles and hillside houses. Arrive in the quaint town of Melk and take a short coach ride to the 900-year-old Benedictine Melk Abbey. Step inside on a guided tour, exploring the ceremonial halls and the magnificent library with its frescoed ceilings before returning to the ship. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Wednesday, December 8, 2027 Passau, Germany Amid the early morning light, cruise past scenic valleys and charming riverside towns to Passau, a 2,000-year-old fairytale city situated at the meeting point of the Danube, Inn, and Ilz rivers. This morning, **it's your choice!** Enjoy a leisurely paced guided walking tour of Passau, also known as the "City of Three Rivers," and take in its ornate Baroque architecture, the cobblestone streets, and St. Stephen's Cathedral, home to Europe's largest church organ - **OR-** join a hike with a local guide up to the pilgrimage church Mariahilf** and be rewarded with spectacular views over Passau. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Thursday, December 9, 2027 Regensburg With an expert guide, discover Regensburg, one of Germany's best-preserved medieval cities. See the first stone bridge built over the Danube and the Porta Praetoria – a Roman gate built in A.D. 179. Stroll through the Old Town to Regensburg's charming Christmas market and marvel at the festive lights and decorations. Spend a free afternoon browsing and shopping at the brightly lit wooden huts holding seasonal ornaments, wooden toys, and local handicrafts. Or perhaps you'll join an optional excursion and experience the beauty and magic of the romantic Christmas market at Thurn and Taxis Palace in Regensburg. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Friday, December 10, 2027 Nuremberg Cruise across the continental divide to Roth and make your way to Nuremberg, a city rich with medieval history. After walking along the pier to reach your coach, join a local expert on a panoramic tour to get your first taste of the city. Continue with a walking tour through Nuremberg's historic streets, strolling for more than an hour as you see the Old Town, 900-year-old ramparts, and Imperial Castle.

Your city tour concludes at Nuremberg's 17th-century Christmas market, which is Germany's oldest. Wander among the wooden booths of local goods, where perhaps you'll shop for handcrafted nutcrackers or treat your taste buds to Nuremberg's famous *lebkuchen* (gingerbread). (B, L, D)

Day 10: Saturday, December 11, 2027 Nuremberg - Disembark Ship - Rothenburg - Würzburg Disembark your ship in Nuremberg and continue on to Rothenburg, a town of medieval walls, fairytale houses, and Christmas markets. Join a local guide in nearby Würzburg, a historic Bavarian city nestled along the banks of the Main River. Embark on a leisurely paced walking tour exploring this Baroque city and its famous Würzburg Residence. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner and toast to the end of your journey along the Danube. (B, D)

Day 11: Sunday, December 12, 2027 Würzburg* - Tour Ends** Say goodbye to Germany as your tour draws to a close. (B)

Important Tour Information:

Book Now rates valid until Dec 05, 2026, valid on air inclusive packages only.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel. Walking two to three miles over the course of a day is no problem for you. You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. Expect some full days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travelers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

Travel with a maximum of four groups of 44 travelers onboard this river cruise itinerary.

*In Vienna, the ship is docked in the city's cruise port of Handelskai, approximately 2 miles from the city center.

In Nuremberg and Regensburg, the walking tours will take approximately 2 hours along cobblestone streets with occasional steps.

**If you choose to participate in the Choice on Tour Mariahilf hilltop church hike, you must be able to walk up and down more than 300 steps.

During the walking tour in Vienna, you should expect walking along cobblestone streets at times, covering approximately 2 miles, and you should be prepared to stand for longer periods, up to 2 hours at a time.

While this tour is appropriate for travelers that require some mobility assistance devices, river cruises cannot accommodate travelers on wheelchairs or with restricted mobility due to gangway access, mooring requirements, and lack of elevator accessibility to every deck of the ship.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

You will be traveling during the heart of a European winter. Expect cold temperatures, likely between 23°F to 41°F, with potential for rain, snow, and icy conditions. Proper footwear and layered clothing are essential for your comfort and safety.

***Driving distance from Würzburg to Frankfurt airport is 79 miles (127 kilometers) and expected traveling time is 1.5 hours depending on traffic.

This itinerary is subject to change due to unforeseen changes in water levels, delays at the locks, and other circumstances that may arise along the waterways. These changes may include items being missed during the tour; however, every effort will be made to substitute another attraction if possible.

Ports of call are subject to change based on pier availability and weather conditions.

While the ship is the primary mode of transportation on this tour, some daily excursions may use coaches, depending on the docking position. The land portion of the tour will include coach transfers and walking tours.

Coaches are restricted in Vienna, Rothenburg, and Nuremberg city centers, and the drop-off and pick-up points are designated by city regulations.

Suites are very limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.

River cruises are smaller ships and only have a limited number of each cabin category available. Specific categories are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Every effort will be made to accommodate your cabin choice at the time of booking; however, if that cabin category is no longer available, the closest available category will be offered. Please inquire at time of booking for any upgrade fees which will apply to different cabin categories. Upgrades are available from Lower to Stateroom, Deluxe Stateroom, and Suite. All cabin upgrades are available on the Amalia and Alexia decks.

Cabins are available on main (Ariane), middle (Alexia), and upper (Amalia) decks. The Ariane deck is connected to the Alexia deck by 12 steps, and there is no elevator access to this deck.

On day 2, embarkation begins at 9:00 a.m., service is available beginning at noon, and cabins are available after 3:00 p.m. On day 8, disembarkation is normally by 9:00 a.m.

Single accommodations are extremely limited. Single rate subject to change based on availability. Triple and child accommodations are not available.

Our arrival transfers will depart from Vienna airport. Our departure transfers will depart for Frankfurt airport.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Our air travelers will arrive into Vienna, Austria airport and depart from Frankfurt, Germany airport.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Due to tour scheduling, return flights should not be booked prior to 10:00 a.m.

The cruise line reserves the right to charge a supplemental fuel charge. Should this charge be incurred, you will be notified in advance.

Gratuities for cabin stewards, bus boys, waiters, and cruise managers onboard the ship are not included.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements.

IMPORTANT: We recommend that travelers take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.

ETIAS visa waiver requirements are anticipated to begin during the last quarter of 2026, for a fee, when visiting a Schengen Area Country. To identify Schengen Area Countries and to complete the ETIAS application, please visit https://travel-europe.europa.eu/etias_en
