

## MHSRA Cutting Horse Event –2<sup>nd</sup> REVISED SCHEDULE

1. There will be **15 Cutting Horse Events** throughout the MHSRA 2022-2023 season. Cuttings 1-3 and 6-14 will be held at an NCHA Sanctioned Cuttings at the Scott County Coliseum, 151 Erle Johnston Dr in Forest, MS, hosted by Central MS Cutting Horse Association. Cuttings 4 & 5 will be held in Jackson at the Equine Center. The State Finals Cutting will be held during the week of MS High School Finals Rodeo in Hattiesburg, MS.
2. Contestant is required to enter and compete at a **minimum of 5** of these Cuttings to be eligible to enter and compete in Cutting at the State Finals.
3. **ALL POINTS EARNED AT THESE 15 CUTTINGS AND AT THE STATE FINALS CUTTING EVENT WILL COUNT TOWARD ALL AROUND POINTS.**

4. Contestant must meet all NHSRA and MHSRA membership requirements in order to enter the cutting at any of these events. Visit [www.mshsra.org](http://www.mshsra.org) for membership information, forms, regulations, messages, and updates.
5. Contestant must meet NCHA Youth membership requirements in order to show in the cutting at any of these events. Youth membership is currently **\$25.00 per calendar year**. The owner of the horse (if different from rider) must also be a member of NCHA which is \$80.00 per calendar year for adults or \$25.00 per calendar year for youth. Visit [www.nchacutting.com](http://www.nchacutting.com) for membership form. Please bring a **copy of horse's registration papers** and **copy of NCHA card** (NCHA membership can be purchased on site) if you are already a member.
6. At Forest, contestants will be competing in the Youth Cutting Class. The current entry fee for the Youth Cutting Class in the Central MS CHA is **\$63.00 per cutting**. Info and entry fees for Cutting 4 & 5 is TBA. A **\$20.00 administrative fee** per cutting will be due MHSRA, if you are not entering other high school rodeo events during the season.
7. Contestants will **ENTER ONLINE at [www.mshsra.org](http://www.mshsra.org)** like all other high school rodeo events. The entries will be forwarded to the secretary of the cutting association. These **entries will close 17 days before the cutting without a late fee and 13 days before the cutting with a late fee**. You may **draw out** no later than **Sunday** prior to the cutting without an excuse and receive a refund of your fees. Please notify MHSRA secretary of an emergency draw out and **send a medical or veterinarian excuse** to the MHSRA secretary no later than **noon on Friday** to receive a refund of fees. The draw or working order will still be done by the Cutting secretary at the show.
8. **At Forest, you will still need to sign in with the Central MS CHA secretary at the show.** Contestants will have the option of joining the local cutting horse association and competing for those points and awards. 9. Points will be awarded to the top 10 MHSRA Boys and top 10 MHSRA Girls members placing in the youth class event. Boys and Girls will be competing in the same class. MHSRA points will be kept separate for Boys Cutting and Girls Cutting to determine top 4 in each to compete at National High School Finals.
