

MHSRA JUNIOR REINED COW HORSE (BOXING) EVENT

1. There will be **14 Reined Cow Horse (Boxing) Events** offered for any **MJHSRA Contestant Members** during the 2023-2024 rodeo season. These will be held during the High School Reined Cow Horse Events. 12 RCH events will be held at our Rodeos on Saturday between JH and HS performances. 2 RCH events will be held at the Dixie National Quarter Horse Show. The State Finals will be held during the week at the MS High School State Finals Rodeo in Hattiesburg, MS.
2. Contestant is required to enter and compete at a **minimum of 4** of these RCH events to eligible to enter and compete at the State Finals and to be eligible for an award.
3. The **Highest Points earned at 8 RCH (Boxing) Events and State Finals RCH (Boxing) Event will count toward year end awards.**
4. **AN AWARD WILL BE GIVEN TO THE MHSRA JUNIOR CONTESTANT WITH THE MOST POINTS EARNED AT THE BEST 8 RCH (BOXING) EVENTS PLUS STATE FINALS. THIS DOES NOT COUNT TOWARD ANY AWARDS OR TITLES IN THE MJHSRA.**

5. Contestant must meet all MJHSRA membership requirements in order to enter the RCH at any of these events. Visit www.mjhsra.org for membership information or www.mshsra.org if you do not plan to enter other events.
6. The entry fees may vary per event. A **\$20.00 administrative fee** per Reined Cow Horse event will be due MHSRA, if you are not entering other junior high school rodeo events during the season.
7. Contestants will **ENTER ONLINE at www.mshsra.org** like all other high school rodeo events. These **entries will close 17 days before the RCH without a late fee and 13 days before the RCH with a late fee.** You may **draw out** no later than **Sunday** prior to the RCH without an excuse and receive a refund of your fees. Please notify MHSRA secretary of an emergency draw out and **send a medical or veterinarian excuse** to the MHSRA secretary no later than **12 noon the day of the event** to receive a refund of fees. The draw or working order will be posted about Wednesday the week before the RCH. **All entry fees, admin fees, and any late fees must be paid at the rodeo before the RCH event starts by cash or check.**
8. **Non-Notified Turnouts:** If you turn out of a RCH event and do not notify the secretary before **12 noon the day of the event** you will be charged a **\$25 fine** plus entry fees. All fines and entry fees must be paid before you will be allowed to compete at a subsequent rodeo.
9. The estimated starting time of each RCH event will be provided prior to each event. These times will vary depending on each association's show schedule.
10. Contestants will have the option of joining the hosting quarter horse association and/or entering their other events and competing for those points and awards.
11. Points will be awarded to the top 10 MHSRA JUNIOR members placing in each event. Boys and Girls will compete in the same class. No points will be kept separate for Boys and Girls. RCH is a co-ed event.
