

MHSRA Reined Cow Horse Event (RCH)

1. There will be **14 Reined Horse Events** throughout the MHSRA 2020-2021 season. These RCH events will be held at either an AQHA sanctioned show, NRCHA sanctioned event, at our rodeos on a Sunday. The State Finals Reined Cow Horse event will be held during the week of MS High School Finals Rodeo.
2. Contestant is required to enter and compete at a **minimum of 5** of these to be eligible to enter and compete in Reined Cow Horse at the State Finals.
3. **ALL POINTS EARNED AT THESE 14 REINED COW HORSE EVENTS AND AT THE STATE FINALS REINED COW HORSE EVENT WILL COUNT TOWARD ALL AROUND POINTS.**

4. Contestant must meet all NHSRA and MHSRA membership requirements in order to enter the cutting at any of these events. Visit www.mshsra.org for membership information, forms, and regulations.
5. Entry forms, entry instructions, and deadline dates to enter will be provided prior to each event.
6. The entry fees will vary per event. A **\$20.00 administrative fee** per Reined Cow Horse event will be due MHSRA, if you are not entering other high school rodeos during the season.
7. The estimated starting time of each RCH event will be provided prior to each event. These times will vary depending on alliance or association show schedule.
8. Contestants will have the option of joining the hosting reined cow horse alliance or quarter horse association and/or entering their other events and competing for those points and awards.
9. Points will be awarded to the top 10 MHSRA members placing in each event. Boys and Girls will compete in the same class. No points will be kept separate for Boys and Girls. RCH is a co-ed event.
10. All points earned at these Reined Cow Horse events plus points earned at the State Finals Reined Cow Horse event will count toward year end points to determine the top 4 contestants who will earn year end awards and qualify to compete at the National High School Finals Rodeo.
