

MHSRA Reined Cow Horse Events 2019-2020

1. There will be **14 RCH Events** throughout the MHSRA 2019-2020 season. These cuttings will be held at a sanctioned event hosted by a RCH horse association or MHSRA. The State Finals RCH will be held during the week of MS High School State Finals Rodeo.
2. Contestant is required to enter and compete at a **minimum of 5** RCH events to be eligible to enter and compete in Cutting at the State Finals.
3. **THE HIGHEST POINTS EARNED AT 14 RCH EVENTS AND AT THE STATE FINALS CUTTING EVENT WILL COUNT TOWARD YEAR END EVENT POINTS AND ALL-AROUND POINTS.**

4. Contestant must meet all NHSRA and MHSRA membership requirements in order to enter the RCH at any of these events. Visit www.nhsra.com and www.mshsra.org for membership forms, regulations and more information.
5. Contestants will be competing in the Youth Class. The current entry fee is **\$62.00 per class, but this does vary based upon the location. A \$15.00 admin fee** will be due to MHSRA.
6. Contestants will **thru the Online Entry Link on the mshsra.org web page. An entry is considered LATE the last three days it is open to enter. The late fee is \$25.** Please bring a **copy of horse's registration papers and coggins to all events.**
7. Contestants will have the **option** of joining the local RCH Assn's & competing for those points & awards.
8. Points will be awarded to the top 10 members in this event who score over the minimum amount of points.
9. The highest points earned at 14 events plus points earned at the State Finals Cutting will count toward year end points to determine the top 4 in Reined Cow Horse event (Boys & Girls are combined into this one class). Year-end awards will be given and you will qualify to compete at the National High School Finals Rodeo.
