Senior High Mission Trip (Grades 9 – 12)

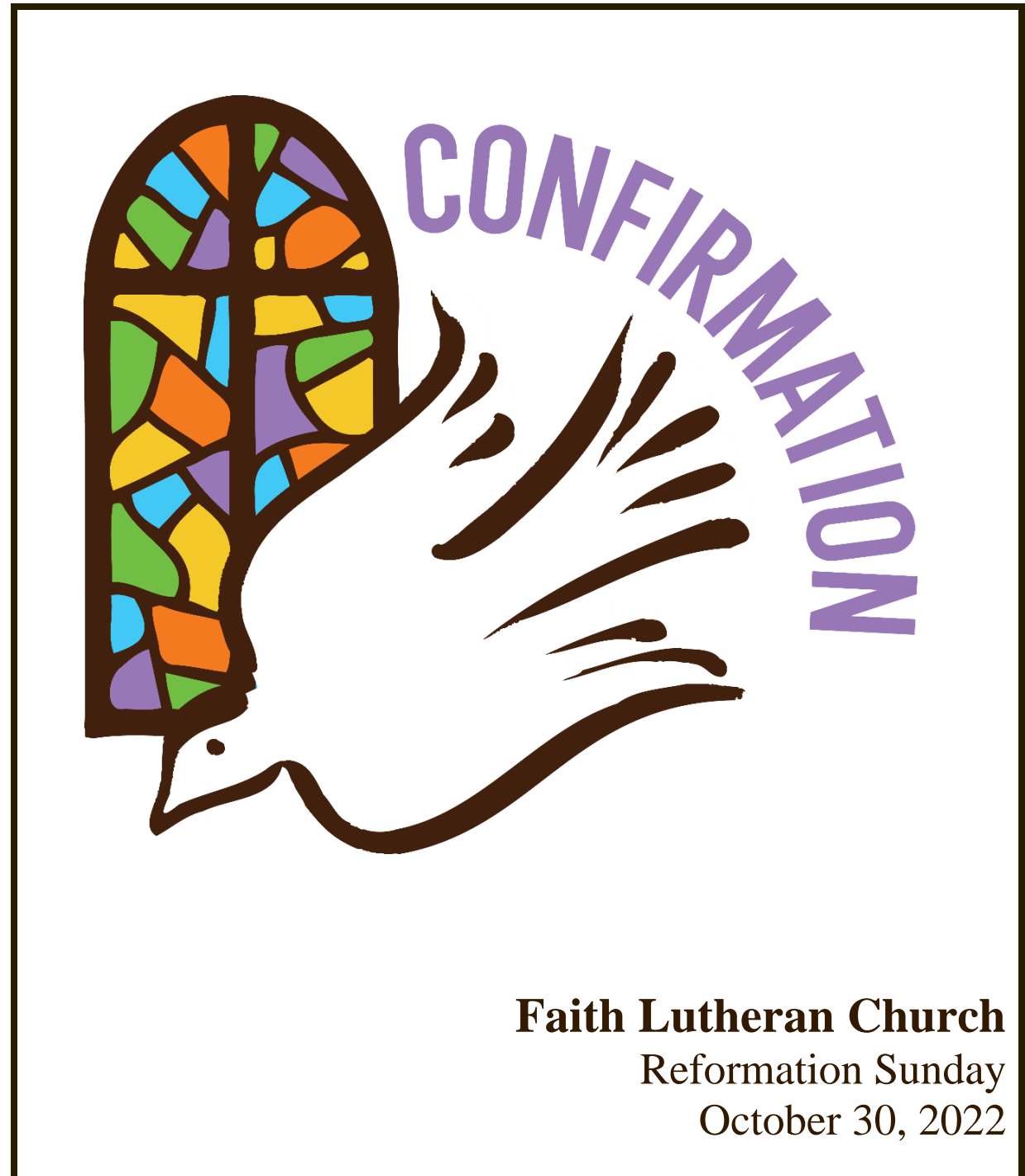
