

Notice of:

Special FLC Congregational Meeting

on Sunday, November 20, 2022 at 10:30 a.m.

Purpose:

Initial approval of updates to our constitution including amendments and bylaws

Notable Changes include:

- Updated changes have been aligned to the 2019 ELCA MODEL CONSTITUTION.
 This means FLC bylaws are now incorporated into the constitution under the appropriate supporting amendments
- Some bylaws have been removed as they are:
 - o already part of an amendment and are no longer needed.
 - o in conflict with a constitutional amendment and amendments take precedence
- Wording in some of the bylaws has been added to better reflect current practices.
- In many of the bylaws, *language has been rewritten* to clearer wording that is more current and easily understood.

Examples of some of the new FLC amendments include:

- **C10.06.** All actions approved by this congregation shall be by majority *vote of those voting members present and voting*, except as otherwise provided in this constitution or by state law.
- C10.08. This congregation may hold meetings by remote communication, including electronically and by telephone conference, as long as there is an opportunity for simultaneous aural communication. To the extent permitted by state law, notice of all meetings may be provided electronically.
- C12.01.The voting membership of the Congregation Council shall consist of officers of the congregation, and not more than 5 members of the congregation.

 C13.06 An Endowment Committee shall be established for the oversight and management of the mission endowment fund. Three voting members of the congregation will be appointed by the Church Council] for a term of 3 years. Members may serve more than one term. (When the Endowment Committee is first established, initial terms for members will be 3-2-1.)

Examples of some of the new FLC bylaws include:

- C8.02.01 VOTING MEMBERS RECEIVING COMMUNION
 Voting members must have communed in person at Faith Lutheran Church or have
 received communion at home from the pastor or lay leader during the current or preceding
 calendar year.
- C12.05.02 ACCOUNTING SYSTEM AND AUDIT
 B. The Congregation Council shall cause the records and books of account of this congregation to be audited, at least once in each fiscal year by the Corporation's Audit Committee and once every five years by an auditing firm.
- C13.06.01 ENDOWMENT COMMITTEE

 If a member of the Committee is unable to fulfill their term, the Congregation Council shall appoint a member for the remainder of that term.

A quorum shall be met when a majority of members are present.

All actions shall pass with a majority vote.

The Committee shall meet at least annually
