TOWN OF MOUNT MORIAH BICYCLE HELMET REGULATION 2021

DEFINITION

Bicycle:

For the purposes of this regulation a bicycle shall mean any vehicle with

two wheels, one in front of the other, propelled by rider.

- 1. This regulation may be citied as the Town of Mount Moriah Bicycle Helmet Regulation, 2021.
- 2. No person shall ride on or operate a bicycle on a street unless that person is wearing a bicycle helmet that is designed for bicycling and is approved by the Canadian Standards Association, the Snell Memorial Foundation or the American National Standards Institute.
- 3. No parent or guardian of a person under the age of twelve authorize or knowingly permit that person to ride on or operate a bicycle on a street unless that person is wearing a bicycle helmet as required by Section 2.
- 4. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this regulation is guilty of an offence as is on summary conviction liable to a maximum fine of twenty-five dollars.
- 5. Any previous regulations and amendments made by the Town Council of Mount Moriah are hereby revoked.
