

TOWN OF MOUNT MORIAH
DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS for 2017 to 2027
AMENDMENT No. 1, 2024

Interested people and associations are invited to submit comments on a proposed amendment to the Development Regulations concerning keeping of roosters as accessory land uses.

The existing entitlement is that birds such as chickens, ducks, and geese may be kept, up to a total of 10 birds on a lot. Lately, keeping of roosters has become a concern because of noise. Council is proposing to prohibit roosters from being kept in the municipal planning area except at the existing agricultural use at the end of the maintained part of Serpentine Road where any number of any species may be kept for agricultural purposes. Any roosters already in place except at that location could continue until their removal or demise, but would not be allowed to be replaced.
