Water/Sewer Disconnection

Just a reminder the deadline to have your taxes paid is quickly approaching. If all taxes for 2023 are *not paid in full by June 30*, 2023 or an agreement plan hasn't been set up, the council will disconnect water service and start court proceedings to collect taxes. If water is disconnected, it will not be turned back on until all taxes have been paid in full, plus \$100.00 Water Off/On fee. Taxes can be paid by Cheque, Cash, Interact Debit or E-Transfer
