Heritage Pay

 After 10 years of membership with Titus, you will receive a 10% discount on membership dues for your 11th season. Every year after, you will receive an additional 10% off your membership dues (up to a total of 50%). For example,

> 11th year = 10% off membership dues 12th year = 20% off membership dues 13th year = 30% off membership dues 14th year = 40% off membership dues 15th year = 50% off membership dues

Monthly Pay

- Due \$145/month beginning March ending July
- Payment option applies for credit card only

Tennis-Only Pay

- Due at time of renewal or conversion
- Membership is limited to tennis courts only (open year round)

Sustaining Pay

- Due at time of placing membership on hold
- Payment by check only
- Membership is placed on hold use of Titus Park is forfeited for the year
- Member may sustain membership for no more than three years

Beautification Fund

- Due by Friday, May 31
- Required for all Members except for Sustaining Members

New Member Dues Explained -

Regular Pay

- One-time investment fee of \$450 plus membership dues of \$725
- Due at time of joining

Monthly Pay

- One-time investment fee of \$450 (due at time of joining)
- Plus \$845 divided over number of remaining months in 2019

Active Military Pay

- Short-term fee of \$100 due at time of joining and annually thereafter
- Membership dues of \$725 contact Bookkeeper for payment schedule
- Policy applies only when at least one parent (not child) is on active military duty.
- Policy does NOT apply to Reserves, CIA, ROTC students, Homeland Security civilians, retired military, disabled retired military, recently discharged military, grown children of military, foreign military, civilian military employees, military contractors, part-time National Guards
- After four years of Active Military Pay/Membership, member is required to pay only the regular membership dues *not* the \$100 short-term fee

Tennis-Only Pay

- One-time investment fee of \$100 plus membership dues of \$360
- Due at time of joining
- Membership is limited to tennis courts only (open year-round)

GUESTS:

The facilities of Titus Park are intended for the enjoyment of the members and their immediate family. Guest privileges should be extended by members sparingly as not to cause inconvenience to fellow members or overload the facilities and staff. Members are restricted to a maximum of four guests per membership family per day and two visits per family per season and five visits per child per season. A \$5 per guest usage fee is required. Prior to any use of the park facilities, guest usage fee must be paid and

guest(s) must register at Park Reception Desk. Guest cards are available for purchase; 6 guests for \$25 or 13 guests for \$50. Members must accompany their guest(s) while using the park facilities.

MEMBERS:

Generally, when a member joins Titus Park, membership includes father, mother, and children. Membership may extend to include a grandparent or nanny, only when primary residence is that of the membership family. Otherwise, a grandparent or nanny may enter and use Park with children of membership family (without paying guest usage fee) only when "filling-in" for parent of membership family.

MEMBERSHIP:

Membership is renewed annually. Invoice is mailed to members during the last week of January.

EXTRAS:

Camp

Camp Titus Day Camp offers fun activities with exciting themes and skill learning for children of members and non-members.

Snack Shack

A variety of snacks, candy, ice cream, and drinks are available. Snack Shack cards may be purchased for \$20.

Special Events

Periodic barbecues prepared and served by Board are offered throughout the swim season. Meals are generally \$5 per person. Inner tube water polo games are held, usually on various Friday evenings, during the summer.
