DEBRIS BURNING INSTRUCTIONS  
CAMPFIRE APPLICATION AND INSTRUCTIONS  
STAGE I & II FIRE RESTRICTIONS

1. No more than 2 (two) piles of debris.
2. Each pile not to exceed 4 feet across and 2 feet high and must be contained in a pit or other fire ring / enclosure.
3. **You Must Call** the FLFD Office during business hours @ 928-535-4644 **"PRIOR"** to burning – leaving a message on the Fire Department recorder will **"NOT"** give you authorization to burn - you must speak to Fire Department Personnel and be registered to burn – per ADEQ regulations. **\*\*You DO NOT need to call the Fire Station to report wanting a campfire – however you should check to see what fire restrictions are in place prior to having a campfire.**
4. Have water onsite and immediately available before burning.
5. **Fire must be fully extinguished by 4pm daily.**
6. No "Broadcast" (whole yard) or "Ditch" (fence line / ditch etc.) burning is allowed at any time.
7. **Campfires** are allowed at this time but ADEQ does not allow for the burning of pine needles in campfires or at night.
8. **Campfires** shall not exceed 3 feet in diameter. Anything larger than 3 feet is **"NOT"** a campfire.
9. Absolutely **"NO"** burning during **"RED FLAG"** advisories.

## STAGE I FIRE RESTRICTIONS



**CAMPFIRES**, charcoal and other fires are **prohibited** - except in designated sites.

*Liquid petroleum and LPG stoves that can be turned on and off are allowed.*



**SMOKING** is **prohibited** outside of vehicles, buildings, and developed recreation sites, unless you are in a 3-foot-diameter area cleared of all burnable vegetation.



**WELDING** or other torches with open flames are **prohibited**.



**FIREWORKS** are always **prohibited**.

## STAGE II FIRE RESTRICTIONS



**CAMPFIRES**, charcoal and other fires are **prohibited** - *Liquid petroleum and LPG stoves that can be turned on and off are allowed and can only be used in an area that is barren or cleared of all overhead and surrounding flammable materials within three feet of the device.*



**SMOKING** is **prohibited** outside of vehicles, buildings, and developed recreation sites, unless you are in a 3-foot-diameter area cleared of all burnable vegetation.



**OPERATING ANY** internal combustion engine is **prohibited** from 9:00am to 8:00pm Arizona time.



**WELDING** or other torches with open flames are **prohibited**.



**EXPLOSIVES** **EXPLOSIVES** are **prohibited**.



**FIREWORKS** are always **prohibited**.

- c. \_\_\_\_\_: Permittee **MUST** have a copy of Approved Burn Permit available on-site at all times
- d. \_\_\_\_\_: Permittee **UNDERSTANDS** there will be **NO** burning when smoke may become a nuisance or safety/health hazard to the general public
- e. \_\_\_\_\_: Permittee **UNDERSTANDS** the Fire Chief and/or any other public officer **MAY ORDER** that the burn be extinguished or prohibit burning during periods of inadequate smoke dispersion, excessive visibility impairment, extreme fire danger and/or safety hazard
- f. \_\_\_\_\_: Permittee **UNDERSTANDS** this permit does **NOT** relieve permittee of liability from damages or obligation to comply with other laws
- g. \_\_\_\_\_: Permittee **UNDERSTANDS** it is their responsibility to know, understand and follow the rules set forth in **ARS13-1706** AND Arizona Administrative Code **R18-2-602**. Violation **WILL** result in the cancellation of this permit. **COULD** result in penalties and/or arrest and/or both
