Black Hugin Reboot Challenge!

Saturday 14th September 2024 4.00PM

Welcome to the Black Hugin Reboot 6 hour challenge! An evening/night run on the Kent coast.

It is advisable to bring insect repellent/bite cream if you are irresistible to mozzies! Headlights are mandatory as there are some very dark sections of the course.

Please ensure you read the little paragraph about going “cupless” and our zero waste vision.

Location :

The Viking Ship Hugin, Sandwich Rd, Cliffsend, CT125HY

Registration :

Will be open from 3pm. Race briefing at 3.50pm.

Weather : Partly cloudy at start, 10% chance of rain with temperature around 15 degrees.

Getting there : No issues on the road that we are aware of.

Course : Plan A is a 3.28 mile loop starting near to the Hugin Viking ship and heading off down the "slope" towards pegwell nature reserve, you will then do a loop around the nature reserve before heading back up the "slope" past the viking ship along the path until you get to a turning that leads you down to the old hover port you will then cut through a very short trail section before heading back to the start. At this point you can choose whether to head off on another loop or ring the bell and claim your medal and goody bag. The course is subject to change as we do have a couple of variations.

Time Limits : There is a six hour time limit. You can finish anytime within this limit. Please be aware that we will need to vacate the car park by 11.30pm as the gates will be locked at this time.

Parking : There is lots of free car parking right where our base camp will be, under the shadow of the viking ship. There is also limited spaces on the road and a small car park down the bottom of the hill.



Toilets : There are toilets located behind the cafe on site.

Numbers : You'll pick this up on race day from the race base camp. (Any elite SVN runners please could you bring your elite number this will be the final time you will be able to use your SVN elite number at Runbelievable)

Lap Counting : We will manually count your laps, just give us a shout or a wave when you come in from each lap.

Runbelievable/SVN miles : Any miles run with us will also count towards your SVN mileage as well as contributing to the RunBelievable club. And for those of you who have earned an elite number through SVN, never fear you can still use it with us too! In fact we ask that you do bring your elite number.

Aid station : We will have an aid station with treats and goodies and jugs of water, juice or cola to refill your bottles. There will be limited room on our tables to leave your drinks so we would encourage you to use your car or bag drop area. The viking cafe will be open at the start of the event and are planning to stay open until 7/8pm.

Bag drop : There will be a small bag drop area or you are more than welcome to use your car.

Doing our bit... Our plan for our events is to be 100% rubbish free. We will be completely "cupless" which means we will not be supplying any bottles or plastic cups, instead we ask can all runners bring their own named bottle or cup which can be replenished freely at the water station. If after the event any runners or spectators have anything to dispose of, please please could you take it home with you!

We are really committed to this and believe together we can all make a difference, so we thank you all in advance for helping us eliminate waste and plastic usage!
