After the lifeguard goes off duty, no one under the age of 16 is allowed on the beach or in the water unless accompanied by an adult member 18 years or older.

(see section 3 letter (l) of by laws)

No eligible resident of Elba Point or the expanded area as defined in Article 111, Section 5 who is not a member of the Beach Club, may use the facility as a guest of a member
