Leader: Christ our Lord invites to his table all who love him, who earnestly repent of their sin and seek to live in peace with one another.

- Leader: Even after he urged us to keep the faith lest we succumb to temptation in the time of trial...

- Leader: But we are here now, Merciful One. As we profess the depth of our gratitude for being called your disciples...
- All: may how we live help heal the pain of the Christ's death.
- Leader: Friends, hear the good news God, who raised Jesus from the dead, offers us new life with Jesus! In the name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven!

## People: In name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven!

All: Glory to God. Amen.
