When attending in-person worship services please remember:

- 1) We must maintain a minimum 6-foot social distance between individuals at all times. Family units (those living in the same household) may be closer together.
- 2) We cannot hug, kiss, or shake hands when on church property while we are observing the 6-foot social distance between individuals.
- 3) Two layers of mask must be worn whenever on church property. The only exception is that masks may be removed for no more than 60 seconds to take Communion when it is offered.
- 4) We cannot sing along with the pre-recorded music during indoor in-person worship. We can hum along with the tune if we wish.
