From the Pastor **God Provided a Way**

everal years ago, in my early ministry, I struggled because my future was uncertain. It caused me to have a lot of sleepless nights or wake up at 2:00 am when fear and anxiety would grab hold of me, making me wonder what was next for me. I am sure many of you can relate in your lives.

Lent is an invitation to self-reflection as we mirror the challenges that Jesus faced in the wilderness. We come to meet our sins, bad habits, and fears in these forty days. I have recognized when I have fallen short; God has remained faithful in my journey. When uncertainty seemed like too much for me, God was faithful. I believe the Lord has sent me to Middleburg-Rectortown Cooperative Parish for an initial purpose to share God's word and point others to grow as followers of Jesus. In times of uncertainty, it is easy to be fearful. In many seasons, I have needed to lean into the Scriptures and listen to The Holy Spirit. In difficult seasons, where I did not know what to do, God provided a way. I have experienced God's faithfulness and know I can trust Him. I plan on making space for God to speak to me this Lent to help me grow into a person who better reflects the love of Christ.

Scripture, journal, and reflect on what God is placing on your heart this Lent. In yet another period of uncertainty in my life, I had a priest share a prayer by the monk Thomas Merton. I invite you to use this prayer [on page 2] throughout your Lenten journey.
