


"I gave my first Treasurer's Report at our orchid meeting tonight but I only pretended to know what I was talking about. Fortunately, the board was only pretending to listen."

These are only a few of the events—there is also the delicious lunch/brunch at the Rooftop Edible Garden. <u>Click here for details</u>.


Early Birding on the Bayfront with Sarasota Audubon, Saturday, September 6

The plant on the left belongs to Don Miller. He found it hanging on the fence along the seawall and mangroves with no tag but it was identified by specialists from the Atlanta Orchid Society.

This is Rhynchovola David Sanders, a hybrid between Brassavola cucullata and Rhyncholaelia digbyana.



These two belong to Maryanne Hazen.

The plant above is a Maxillaria tenuifolia and is usually a good bloomer.

And surprisingly enough, the cymbidium on the left blooms every year even though they prefer the California cooler nights. Several orchid growers have given us supplies which we're making available to our members for a nominal cost. We have many plastic liner pots, mounting supplies, wire supports/attachments. We'll try to have some of them available at the next few meetings or you can contact either Sharon or Maryanne for more information.

I still have a pink bag with gloves, an apron & clippers was left at the meeting – is it yours? You must be missing the nice clippers! Contact Maryanne to retrieve them. I'll bring them to the next few meetings and hope to find the rightful owner.

Rhynchostylis (Foxtail Orchid)

Rhynchostylis is a genus of orchids native to the Indian subcontinent region. It is commonly called the foxtail orchid since it's infloresence looks like the "bushy" tail of the diminutive canine. Rhyncostylis are closely related to Vandas and come in a multitude of colors.
