WHAT IS MICROBLADING?

Microblading (or eyebrow embroidery, feathering, or 3D brow) is a relatively new manual method, which does not use a normal Permanent Makeup Machine. i.e (tattoo needle)

Microblading is becoming an incredibly popular treatment as more and more people like the fine, soft results that it can offer.

The pigment is implanted in the basal membrane which divides the epidermis from the dermis layer of the skin.

This technique is therefore more superficial than tattooing. This amazing eyebrow treatment suits people who ideally have the wrong brow shape, over plucked brows, loss of hair, patchy areas that wont grow back, or through medical reasons such as Alopecia or Chemotherapy. (or essentially all the Drew Berrymore/Pam Anderson lovers from the 90's..lol)

***NOTE *** The sharp hair like strokes will fade out resulting in a soft, light natural pretty shade and shape. Only permanent makeup will keep hairlike strokes.

Microblading gently enhances clients' natural features, giving them more confidence in their overall appearance, however it does not react the same for certain skin types:

- * Excessive Sebum/Oily Skin/Acne
- * Problem Skin; broken Capillaris/Moles
- * Keratosis/Seborrheic Dermatitis
- * Very dry/Peeling skin

NOTE Clients with this skin type needs to be aware that the ink does not last as long which requires frequent touch ups

BOOKING THE APPOINTMENT

In order to ensure your appointment is secure, I require a \$200.00 deposit which is paid by bank transfer prior to the appointment date. This is then deducted from the final price. Consent forms will be emailed to you which must be completed and brought with you to the appointment. The session could be cancelled if you do not bring your consent form with you signed.

NOTE Consultations happen on the same day as your booked appointment

WHAT HAPPENS AT THE APPOINTMENT?

Please arrive 10 minutes before your treatment time. Late arrival can lead to your treatment being postponed to another day to avoid upsetting other clients who may be waiting for their appointments after yours.

When you arrive, I clean your brow area with sterile wipes, and place numbing cream on the area so it can soak for 20 minutes or so. We can take that time to talk about the procedure, what to expect, and talk about shape, colour and downtime/healing time.

I pride myself on creating comfort for my clients, and understand it can be a mix of nerves/excitement. I won't begin blading until we both agree 100% on shape and style. I then begin Microblading with a sterile Micro-blading tool and disposable blade during your procedure.

I use regulated semi permanent makeup high quality pigments, specially manufactured for Micro pigmentation. My pigments are made in Korea and are non-toxic, and antioxidant. Great for most skin types

HOW LONG DOES IT LAST?

6 months to a year. It also depends on your skin type. (oily skin types won't last as long). Most bladers will say 1-3 years, however at the 6 month mark, your brows begin to fade, and deshape. Ink will technically be there maybe in 3 years, but the shape will be gone.

DO NOT BE ALARMED if after your scabs fall off, your brows do not look perfectly full. Instead they look extremely light and unfinished, just remind yourself that this is a TWO STEP PROCESS. Microblading happens on the thinnest part of the face, and the ink does not pick up evenly, hence why the follow up is included in the initial price, SO BE PATIENT.

After your first appointment, your brows will look perfect and will also satisfy you with your desired shape, however your brows will be EXTREMELY DARK (about 50% darker than your desired shade) When the scabs fall of and they are healed, you will notice the ink is much lighter and would need another pass (hence the follow up appointment) BE PATIENT **

DURING SCAB TIME

NOTE This does not happen to most clients, this is to educate on the possibilities of this happening to you, and to prepare you.

Everyone heals differently, Sometimes when scabs are fresh and are in the initial stages of falling off, the ink can appear much redder than the desired shade, if this happens, just keep going, the colour will cool in a few days. Observe below...

Another common situation during scab time is a milky white sheet over top of the ink and it appears that there is absolutely no ink there. DON'T PANIC- when this happens, the ink will darken in a week or so.

****Trust in the process, and BE PATIENT****

Once you come in for your touch up 8-10 weeks later, your brows will look fuller.

DOES IT HURT?

No, not really, on a scale from 1-10, most clients report a discomfort of about 3-6.

At the beginning of your treatment you will feel a scratching feeling while I am doing my first pass, and marking the shape and design of the brow with my hand tool. A numbing gel is then applied which is absorbed into the skin within a few seconds. Once the gel is absorbed, very little remains

AFTERCARE: Touch ups

You will need to return for your follow up treatment no later than 8-10 weeks after your first treatment. To avoid any additional charges, please give a minimum of 72 hours for cancellations. The \$200.00 deposit is non refundable.

Everyone heals differently and most clients will see that the ink is much lighter and did not pick up on certain areas after the first treatment. It is important to understand that this is a two part process, so please be diligent and calm, and the second treatment will complete the process after healing, revealing the result. **PLEASE BE PATIENT AND DO NOT PANIC!**

IMPORTANT...Residual pigment, blood,white blood cells, ect. can arise from the open wound. During the first 24 hours, I ask clients to “gently wash the skin” to remove/prevent build up and dust particles. You should dab this away once or twice WITH STERILE WATER for the first day. For the remaining healing time or UNTIL SCABS ARE GONE, DO NOT TOUCH THE ENTIRE AREA..(Forehead to lower lashes) No creams, No water, NO sweating...This is to help get the best retention.

* NOTE * For best results, (AFTER SCABS FALL OFF) apply coconut oil/or Rose Hip oil after your brows heal. They holistically heal the brows as well as retain pigment for a longer time.

IMPORTANT NOTE: avoid Vaseline, or Petroleum Jelly during healing period. It suffocates the skin and does not allow your brows to breathe. It could cause more scabbing and create little retention. Also avoid Vit E, Q10, Polysporin/Neosporin,Bio Oils etc. These products want to help your skin by removing anything foreign, (hence the ink), and reduce retention, or cause irritation.

10-14 DAY HEALING PERIOD avoid...

- * Tanning beds/sun tanning(brows worst enemy)
- * No sweating at gym (try to avoid aggressive workouts)
- * No makeup on Brows
- * DO NOT pick scabs or itch them

and lastly... ENJOY THEM!!! so long to the extra 20 mins dealing with them every morning..lol BEST INVENTION EVER!!!!!!!!!!!!!!
