# WHO WE ARE



#### **MetroWest Free Medical Program**

- We provide free, high-quality medical care to uninsured and underinsured individuals in the MetroWest region.
- We are an entry point to the health care system providing immediate health related care and connections to other health resources.
- Our volunteer-driven model ensures access to essential healthcare services, addressing gaps in the healthcare system and improving community well-being.

#### **Service Delivery Locations & Schedule**

- Clinics operate in the MetroWest region, in Marlborough and Sudbury.
- Evening clinic hours ensure accessibility for working individuals.
- General Medicine 3 Tuesday evenings/month;
  Women's Health 3 Thursday evenings/month;
  and Vision on 1 Monday evening per month
- Patients are seen on an appointment basis.
  Waitlists for services are currently six months or longer due to high demand.

**General Medicine**: Provides free primary care services for uninsured and underinsured patients, addressing acute and chronic conditions, preventive care, and health education. Volunteer physicians, nurses, and medical professionals offer compassionate care to help patients manage their overall health.

Women's Health: Specializes in free gynecological and reproductive health services, including routine exams, breast and cervical cancer screenings, family planning, and menopause support. The clinic is dedicated to improving women's health and well-being through accessible, high-quality care.

**Vision Care**: Offers free eye exams, screenings for conditions like glaucoma and diabetic retinopathy, and prescription glasses for uninsured and underinsured patients. Volunteer optometrists and ophthalmologists work to ensure that patients have access to essential vision care.
