IntelliSiren Park model: This unit features a controller, flashing lights, and up to 4 speakers that sound a siren followed by voice files for the specific alert type.

WeatherCall Services provides automated alerting for chosen National Weather Service-issued warnings, followed by warning expiration, with up to 10 customizable messages. The estimated range for voice files is 1,250 feet, depending on atmospheric conditions. Perfect for RV parks, campgrounds, large parking lots, recreation areas, sports complexes, and other areas where larger groups of people gather.

IntelliSiren® Park model (TechTrol Model IS-1500)

This unit flashes lights, sounds a siren, and plays pre-recorded audio files when NWS warnings include its location or lightning is within 6–10 miles (user-selectable). External speaker(s) connect via a 4-foot cable. Size: 20" tall x 12" wide x 8" deep; plus 10" antenna; includes 6-foot AC plug. Max output: 130 dB –siren audible up to 2,400 ft, messages to 1,200 ft (atmosphere-dependent). Supports up to 4 speakers for 360° coverage. Uses cellular signal to communicate with WeatherCall servers monitoring threats 24/7. Alerts stop and all-clear messages play when warnings expire or 15–30 minutes after the last lightning strike (user-selectable). Requires A/C power; 4-hour battery backup included. An optional solar unit is available. Ten pre-recorded .mp3 files play during warnings/lightning—eight cover tornado, severe thunderstorm, lightning, and flash flooding (plus all-clears), along with test and siren files. Siren can precede messages (user-selectable). Ten additional user-customizable audio files can be activated via the IntelliSiren web app.

PHONE CALL/TEXT/EMAIL NOTIFICATION OPTION

Up to 5 contacts can receive warnings, lightning, and “all-clear” notices by call, text, or email.

Solar Option

Includes 6-foot Optional solar panels and battery available for off-grid use.

Standard Features

Web app enables tests, custom messages, radar viewing, lightning strike locations, and warning polygons. Unit self-reports every 2 hours; designated contacts get emails if communication is lost. Requires no maintenance; 1-year warranty. Backup battery lasts ~3 years. Automated activation requires an active WeatherCall monitoring plan (monthly or annual); no refund if automation is discontinued. 1-year repair/replacement warranty for workmanship. After 1 year, repairs/replacements are the customer's cost.

QR Code for Visitors

Optional WeatherCall Community QR code lets guests opt into calls/texts while onsite—ideal for recreation areas, RV parks, campgrounds, hotels, and resorts.
