IntelliSiren® Alarm: All-in-one control unit with a high-pitched speaker and 2 flashing lights, one for lightning detection within 10 miles, and the other for a Tornado Warning. Siren sounds every 10 minutes (user-defined) as the lights flash until 30 minutes after the last lightning strike within 10 miles, or the expiration of the Tornado Warning. Perfect for pools, playgrounds, and small spaces where people gather.

IntelliSiren® Alarm model (TechTrol Model IS-1200)

The IntelliSiren Alarm activates a high-pitched audible alarm and flashes strobe lights when the unit is within either a National Weather Service-defined tornado warning or if a cloud-to-ground lightning strike has been detected within 6 to 10 miles (user selectable). The unit contains one audio speaker with a maximum output of 120 dB, allowing it to be heard 500 feet away. Its dimensions are approximately 12" tall, wide by 5" deep. An attached antenna adds 10" to the unit's height when installed.

The unit uses a cellular signal to communicate with the WeatherCall servers, which monitor National Weather Service weather alerts and warnings, along with lightning detection data from numerous sources. Once a warning expires, or 15 or 30 minutes after the last lightning strike within the monitored range (user selectable), the unit stops flashing the light and sounding the periodic alarm sounds.

PHONE CALL/TEXT/EMAIL NOTIFICATION OPTION

IntelliSiren Alarm sends tornado warning and lightning activation and cancellation notifications to up to 5 people via any combination of phone calls, SMS text, and email for an additional one-time fee.

STANDARD FEATURES

An accompanying web-app customizes the alarm sound, duration, repetition frequency, and tests the alarm and lights. The app also displays NWS-based radar, recent lightning strike locations, and current NWS-issued weather warnings. The unit requires A/C power and has a battery backup that lasts up to 4 hours in the event of a power loss. An optional solar-powered battery is also available for an extra charge. The unit also self-checks communication and power with the WeatherCall server daily, alerting administrators via email if there is a unit failure. No maintenance of the unit is required. The back-up battery's expected lifetime is three years based on environmental conditions and usage.

The unit must be purchased with a monitoring and activation plan paid monthly or annually, provided by WeatherCall Services. If the monitoring plan is cancelled by the user, there is no refund on the unit. The unit comes with a 1-year repair or replacement warranty if the unit fails due to workmanship. The unit must be shipped back to the manufacturer. After 1 year, the customer is responsible for the repair and replacement costs.
