As part of our on-going effort to ensure that this community is a safe place to live, we are pleased to announce a new program is about to begin. This service is completely unique and is free to you, paid for by the community.

HazardCall is a total community messaging service. It is a precise weather and other hazards alerting service that lets you know about weather threats. HazardCall will call you with important safety information in an extreme weather threat that could injure you or worse; threats like tornadoes, hurricane force winds, very large hail and flash flood emergencies. We will not call you unless the threat is that serious. For all other threats, you will get a text and/or email.

It is also a way for the community itself to communicate with you through text and email for important messages.

We realize many of you have your favorite weather apps or resources, but would you stake your life on them? Apps and weather radios often give false alarms because they are based on countywide not storm-specific warnings. The government Wireless Emergency Alerts always warn somebody for no reason. You can stake your life on the reliability of HazardCall. A decade of delivering tens of millions of notifications, it will give you the information you need before dangerous or deadly weather strikes.

You will soon receive a welcome text and email with an important link to install the HazardCall app on your smartphone. While installing the app is optional, we recommend it so you can get additional weather information. Even without the app, you will still get the phone calls for extreme severe weather to ensure you know when there is a life-threatening situation, along with text messages and emails for community notifications.

Dangerous and impactful weather should never be a surprise. Weather conditions can and do change suddenly and we are confident that using HazardCall will help you anticipate what is expected so you can adjust your plans and avoid danger.
