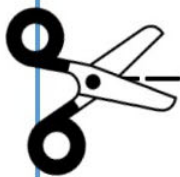

# Snow Tubing

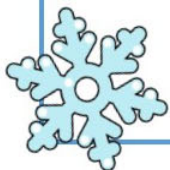

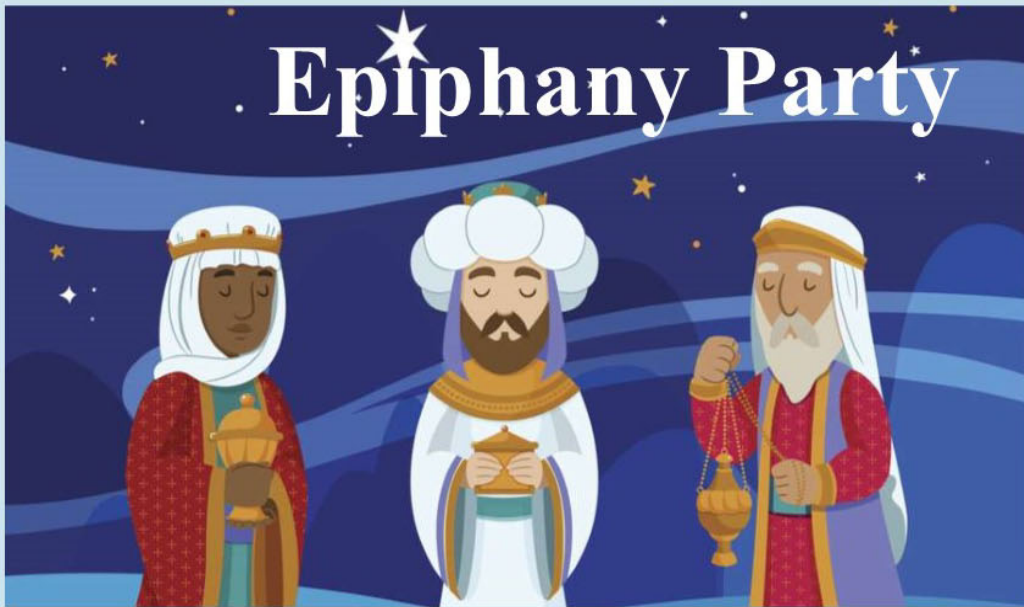
