Final Selection Process

A committee of 3 to 5 Lodge 112 FOP and FOPA members will review the nominations and select the final recipient. The presentation will be conducted at a General Membership Meeting.

Referrals will be collected until December 31st with a presentation at the February Meeting

Referrals will be collected until March 31st with a Presentation at the May Meeting

Referrals will be collected until June 30th with a presentation at the August Meeting

Referrals will be collected until September 30th with a presentation at the November Meeting

Recognition

The recipient will be invited to the next membership meeting with a supervisor and up to 6 more guests. During the meeting the recipient will be presented a certificate with a citation for the award (based on the referral), a pin to be worn on their uniform and a \$100 gift card. Attempts will be made to have the presentation reported in a local newspaper.
