Enlist E3 Soybeans

Enlist E3 Soybeans are the first three-gene, herbicide-tolerant trait stack soybeans to come to market thanks to Dow Agrosciences and MS Technologies. Enlist E3 Soybeans show superior tolerance to the new 2,4-D Choline, glyphosate, and glufosinate herbicides, and the application window is similar to what you are used to with the Round-Up Ready system. Opheim Seed & Chemical is excited about the E3 approval and believes this will give farmers another management tool to battle resistant weeds without having to sacrifice bushels. We will have many E3 varieties in our plot ranging in maturity from 1.8 to 2.8 and will be holding several training days this summer to evaluate the E3 platform.
