

Sara Sammakia is a contemporary visual artist whose work has propelled her to the forefront of the Modern Pop art scene. Her work is a vibrant and meticulously crafted embodiment of our relationship with consumer culture and our obsession with celebrity, with her finger firmly on the pulse of current popular culture, Sammakia has been dubbed the 'flag bearer for the millennial generation'.

The artist's seminal 'We've All Gone Mad' series is a commentary of the social structures of the digital age. The kaleidoscopic manner, in which Sammakia portrays familiar corporate giants in a hyper-bricolage of imagery, strips the icons of their relevance and confronts our own personal reltionships with the mascots, logos and motifs that serve as the make-up of our daily lives.

The craftsmanship and execution of Sara's work is irrefutable evidence of her talent as a painter, and when put into the context of the 21 st Century, the imagery packs a provocative punch. On one hand an homage to the evolving landscape of new age lifestyles and on the other a scathing portrayal of the sins of the modern world.

As Sammakia's career has evolved so too has the demand for her work. Her portraiture commissions of a host of celebrities has seen her work adorn the walls of some of the most famous stars today, whereas sell-out appearances at art fairs and an auction sale at *Christies*, *London*, fetching above the estimate, prove that this young and ambitious artist is steadily heading towards and an exciting and lucrative career.

Playful and unapologetic, Sammakia's visual language dismantles our preconceptions of Western ideals and the American dream.
