

IMPORTANT INFORMATION & TIPS

At PFS Global, we aim to make your container delivery and collection as smooth as possible. Here are some important tips to follow when receiving your shipping container:

1. PREPARING YOUR DELIVERY LOCATION

- Ensure the delivery site is **safe**, **clear**, **and easily accessible** for the truck.
- The container must be placed on level, stable ground to avoid movement or damage.
- Allow sufficient space for the truck to manoeuvre, especially for side loader or tilt tray deliveries.
- Check for overhead powerlines, trees, or obstructions that may interfere with delivery.
- If delivery is to a driveway or yard, confirm that the surface can support the weight of the truck and container, and any required council permits obtained
- Decide **container door direction**, for easy access and loading/unloading. Remember container is dropped from driver's side of the truck for sideloaders.

2. OPENING YOUR CONTAINER SEAL

- Every shipping container is secured with a **seal** for security and customs purposes.
- **Record the seal number** before breaking it (this may be required for customs or your own records).
- Use a **bolt cutter or grinder** to safely remove the seal. Always wear gloves and eye protection.
- Keep the removed seal with your documentation until unpack is complete.

3. DURING AND AFTER UNPACK

- Sweep out all debris (pallet wrap, dunnage, strapping, or product waste) once the container is empty.
- Remove any nails, timber, or packaging that could damage the container.
- Avoid leaving any cargo residue inside containers must be returned clean and free of debris.
- If container cleaning is not completed, detention or cleaning fees may apply.

4. CONTAINER COLLECTION

- Ensure the container is accessible for truck collection at the agreed time.
- Double-check the container is completely empty, swept clean, and with doors securely closed.
- If delivery was on a sideloader, ensure there is clear space for the container to be lifted safely.
