

ORDINANCE NO. 63

An Ordinance of the City of Log Cabin, Texas providing for the placement of political signs within the city.

I.

As an exception to other sign regulations and a temporary privilege during political campaigns, political advertising signs meeting the requirements herein, shall be permitted.

II.

With the consent of property owners, temporary political advertising signs may be placed on private property.

III.

Such signs shall be placed on or near the dividing line between private property and a public right-of-way, and no such sign shall be placed as to create a traffic hazard.

IV.

All political signs shall be stenciled or professionally printed to present a uniform appearance.

V.

All political signs or advertisements shall be removed three (3) days or seventy two (72) hours after an election.
