


CITY OF LOG CABIN

ORDINANCE NO. 59
(Revised 4/10/02)

An Ordinance of the City of Log Cabin, Texas, prohibiting the accumulation of junk and other unsightly materials as defined in this Ordinance, and providing for a penalty.

Whereas because of prevailing conditions existing in the environment, create health hazards and an unsightly or depreciation of appearance on any lot, tract or parcel of land with in the City of Log Cabin, shall be prohibited.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Log Cabin, Texas, it shall be unlawful to allow the accumulation of:

1. Machinery, motors, etc.
2. Old appliances such as refrigerators, washing machines, dryers, sinks, tubs, etc.

Such implementation to take effect immediately.

Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty upon conviction in the Municipal Court and shall be fined \$200.00 to \$500.00. The violation(s), as long as it remains, shall be deemed a separate violation and shall be punished accordingly.
