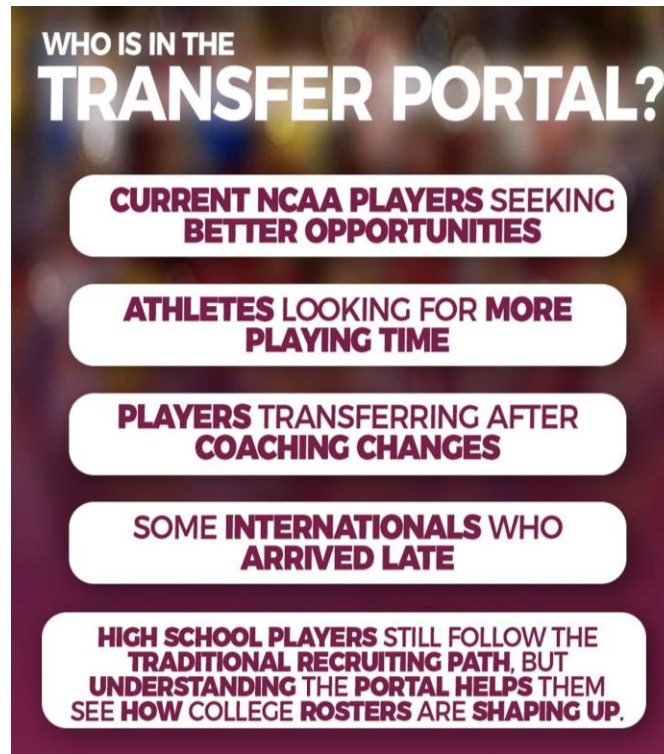

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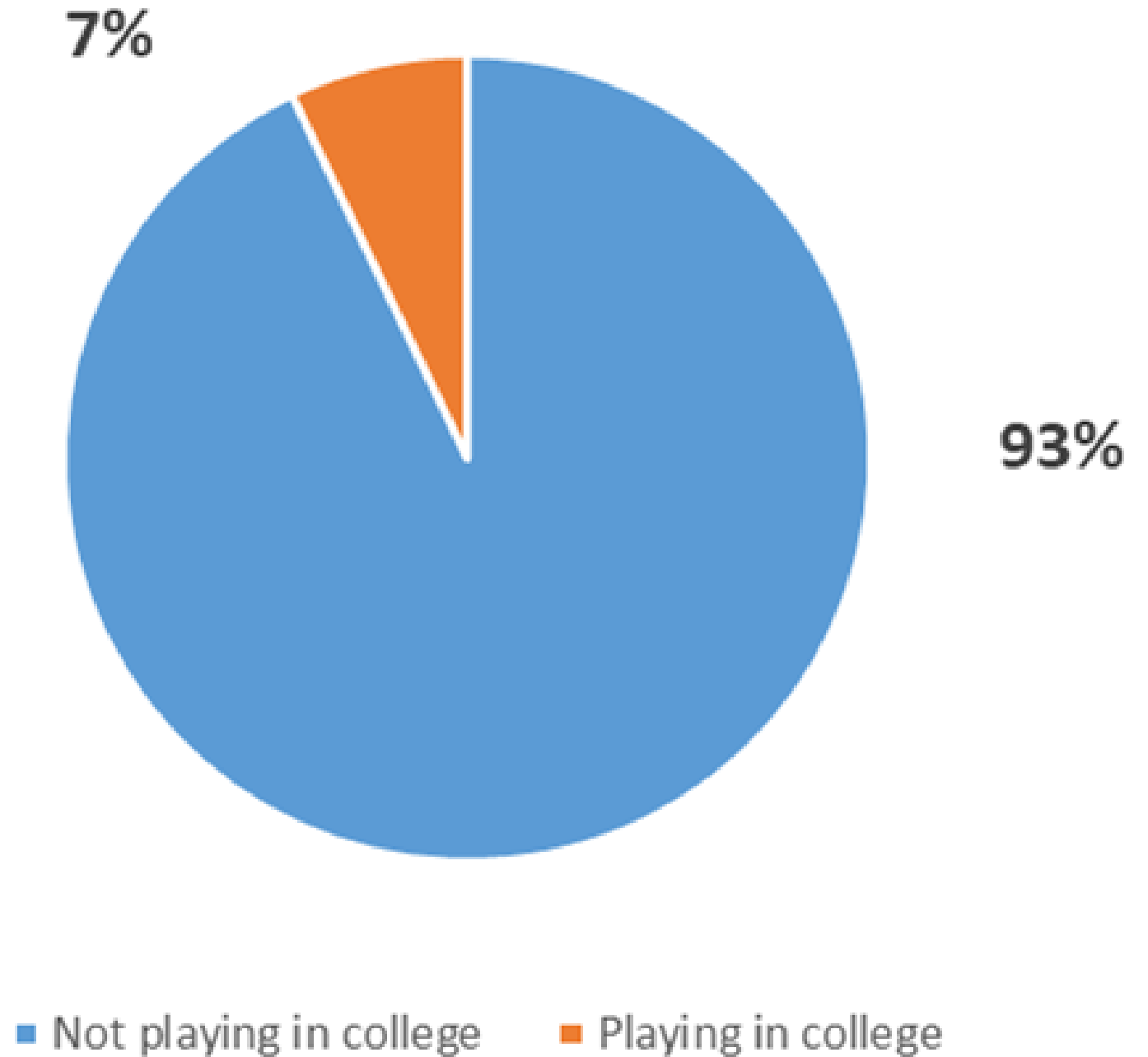

Let's walk through an example

Division	# of Teams	Total Players	Average Roster	Scholarship Limit	Average Scholarship
NCAA II	286	5,952	21	7.2	7,840

Full Price for One Year of College: \$20,000.

Program has 7 scholarships: $\$20,000 \times 7 = \$140,000$. Total Scholarship Dollars

Team has 20 Student Athletes: $\$140,000 / 20 = \$7,000$. per student athlete on Athletic Scholarship

Full Price for One Year – Athletic Scholarship: $\$20,000 - \$7,000 = \$13,000$. *Balance to be Paid*

Academic Scholarships are typically directly calculated from your GPA.

Examples:

3.0 = \$4,000.

3.25= \$6,000.

3.50= \$8,000.

3.75= \$10,000.

4.0 = \$12,000.

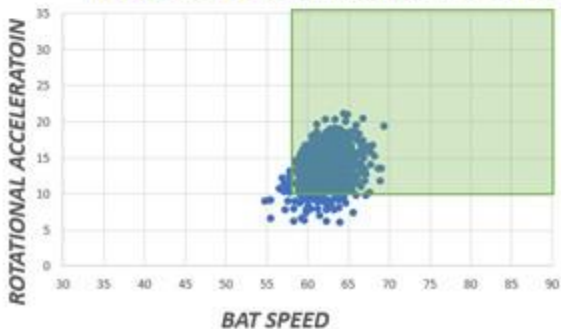


Bat Speed is a hitter's **raw power** - the faster the bat moves, the farther and harder the ball can go. Rotational Acceleration is the hitter's **power efficiency** or the power of their engine.

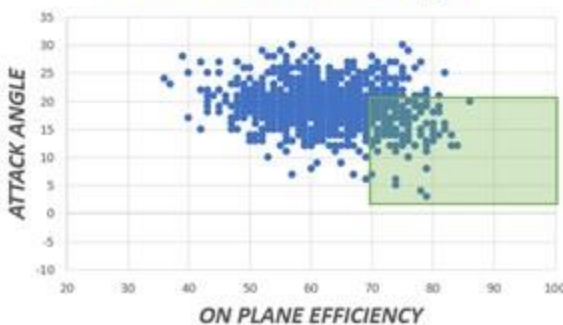


On Plane Efficiency is how direct the hitter's **swing path** was towards contact - think chainsaw. Attack Angle measures the **swing direction** towards the incoming pitch. Positive Attack Angles match the incoming negative

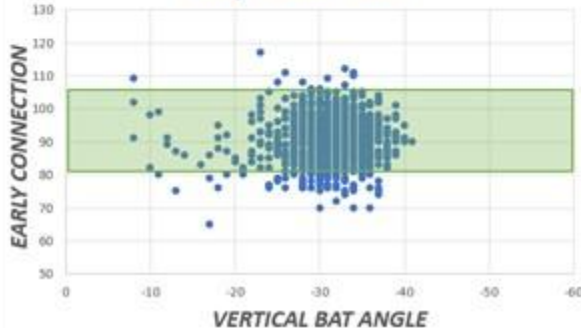

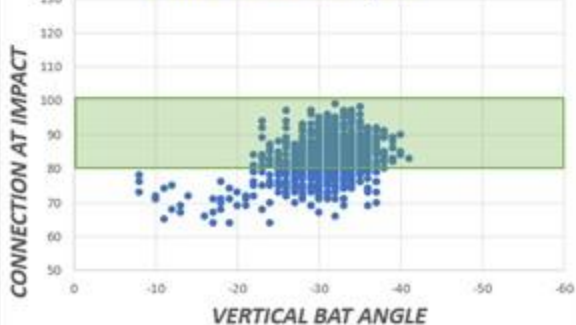
