

Let's walk through an example

	# of		Average	Scholarship	Average
Division	Teams	Total Players	Roster	Limit	Scholarship
NCAA II	286	5,952	21	7.2	7,840

Full Price for One Year of College: \$20,000.

Program has 7 scholarships: $$20,000 \times 7 = $140,000$. Total Scholarship Dollars

Team has 20 Student Athletes: \$140,000 / 20 = \$7000. per student athlete on Athletic Scholarship

Full Price for One Year – Athletic Scholarship: \$20,000 - \$7,000 = \$13,000. Balance to be Paid

Academic Scholarships are typically directly calculated from your GPA.

Examples:

3.0 = \$4,000.

3.25= \$6,000.

3.50= \$8,000.

3.75= \$10,000.

4.0 = \$12,000.
