Probationary Status

- Fund Raiser Participation
- General Participation i.e. drills, special assignments, and/or assisting in hall as well as responding to emergency calls.

Any applicant with a driver's license whether intending to drive or not, will also need to complete the attached OLN waiver for validation of license status.
