



Kennewick Kiwanis Club Children's Coloring Contest

Official Rules and Regulations

The Kennewick Kiwanis Club Children's Coloring Book Contest encourages creativity, celebrates local children, and supports the club's commitment to helping children learn, dream, grow, and succeed. Participants are invited to color an official contest page and submit for friendly judging.

The Kennewick Kiwanis Club Children's Coloring Book Contest begins on August 22, 2026, at the Benton Franklin Fair & Rodeo Parade. Entries will be reviewed by judges selected by the Kennewick Kiwanis Club. Judging will be based on creativity, effort, use of color, age-appropriate neatness, and overall presentation. The judges' decisions are final. *Submitted entries will become part of the contest record and will not be returned.*

Children may participate using the official coloring page, available in the following ways:

- 1) Pick up a free coloring book at the Benton Franklin Fair & Rodeo Parade. Kiwanis members will give away 5,000 books, with the entry page inside the front cover.
- 2) Print the official coloring page from the Kennewick Kiwanis Club website or use the QR code.

Eligibility

- The contest is open to children in the Kennewick/Tri-Cities area.
- Children may enter in one of the following age divisions: ages 4–6, ages 7–9, and ages 10–12.
- Family members of Kennewick Kiwanis Club members may participate. To ensure fairness, all entries will be judged without participant names visible to the judges.
- No purchase or donation is required to participate.

How to Enter

1. Use the official Kennewick Kiwanis Club coloring page, available in the free coloring book, on the contest [website](#), or by scanning the QR code above.
2. Complete the coloring page using crayons, colored pencils, markers, or other similar child-safe art materials.
3. Write the child's name, age, parent or guardian name, phone number, and email address on the entry form or on the back of the coloring page.
4. Submit the completed entry by the posted deadline at one of the following Mid-Columbia Libraries' locations:
 - Keewaydin Park – 405 S. Dayton Street, Kennewick
 - Kennewick – 1620 S. Union Street, Kennewick
 - Pasco – 1320 W. Hopkins Street, Pasco
 - West Pasco – 7525 Wrigley Dr., Pasco
 - West Richland – 3803 W. Van Giesen St., West Richland

Entry Requirements

- Each child may submit one entry featuring their own coloring work.
- Adults may help with instructions, contact information, and submission, but not with the coloring.
- Entries must be family-friendly and must not contain offensive, harmful, or inappropriate content.
- Incomplete, late, altered, or difficult-to-identify entries may be disqualified.
- Submitted entries will become part of the contest record and will not be returned.



Contest Dates and Drop-Off Locations

Contest begins: August 22, 2026

Entry deadline: September 15, 2026

Winners announced on the website: No later than October 15, 2026

Prizes and Recognition

- Prizes may be awarded by age division: ages 4–6, ages 7–9, and ages 10–12.
- Prize details, pickup instructions, and winner notification will be provided on the [website](#) or by scanning the QR code.
- Prizes are not transferable and may not be exchanged for cash.

Special thanks to **Dairy Queen** for donating ice cream treats to the **first 150 eligible children** and for the Mid-Columbia Libraries for distributing them. Qualifying children will receive a coupon at the library when they submit their entry.

Parent or Guardian Permission, Privacy, and Safety

By submitting an entry, the parent or legal guardian confirms that the child has permission to participate and that the information provided is accurate. The parent or guardian also authorizes the Kennewick Kiwanis Club to contact them regarding the contest.

Personal information collected for this contest will be used only for contest administration, winner notification, and related recognition. Children should not include home addresses, school addresses, phone numbers, or other private information on the front of their artwork.

Use of Entries and Publicity

Submitted entries may be displayed at club events, community locations, in club communications, or online. The Kennewick Kiwanis Club may use the child's first name, age division, and artwork for contest promotion or recognition. The club will not publish personal contact information.

General Conditions

- The Kennewick Kiwanis Club reserves the right to modify, suspend, or cancel the contest if necessary.
- The club may disqualify any entry that does not follow these rules or appears to involve misconduct.
- The club is not responsible for lost, late, damaged, misdirected, or illegible entries.
- Participation in the contest constitutes acceptance of these official rules and regulations.
- Submitted entries will become part of the contest record and will not be returned.
