Texas Milestones

Soon after diagnosis

- Sign up for all the Waiver Interest Lists.
- Build a positive support circle (friends, other parents, support groups)
- Find Early Intervention (EI) and Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE)
- Explore Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) and other therapies.

Reaching School Age

- Review the IDEA Parent Guide to help you advocate for your child's education.
- Request and prepare for an evaluation from your school:
 - Individual Education Program (IEP) describes the special education instruction, supports, and services that your child will receive
 - o 504 Plan removes barriers, makes accommodations, and adds assistive technology.
- Learn about the ARD process and prepare at SpedTX. Consider a special needs advocate.

Entering High School

- Meet with your ARD committee on your child's transition plan out of the school system.
- Meet with Texas Workforce Commission for summer job opportunities.

Becoming an Adult

- Apply for Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Open an ABLE account
- Find safety classes for living, traveling, and working.
- Meet with a special needs attorney to set up Guardianship (or alternatives) and a Special Needs Trust
- Create a plan or Letter of Intent (LOI) for and share with professionals and your support circle.
- Health Care Transition process of getting youth ready for health care as an adult.
- Learn about transportation options, including Rideshare (Uber/Lyft), Buses, DART, Rides to appointments through <u>insurance/Medicaid</u>, and Volunteer Drivers.

Before Graduation & Beyond

- Explore opportunities outside of the home to strengthen daily living and vocation skills.
- Consider higher and continued education options/colleges in Texas:
