Start with what you have and make plans to grow and adapt.



Location

- Short distance to parking spaces
- Close to drive up drop-off.
- Access to secure playground or outside area
- Near restrooms.



Features

- Sensory walls
- Separate rooms visible through windows and Dutch doors.
- Spaces for pacing, calming down, learning, playing, sensory seeking, and social time.
- Doors with delay open
- Dimmable & non-fluorescent lighting with covers or removable options.



Equipment

- Changing table (adult-sized)
- Cubbies, coat racks, and secure storage
- Swing, teepee, trampoline with grab bars
- Evacuation crib and wheelchairs



Tools

- Noise-blocking earmuffs
- Timers
- All sizes of diapers and spare clothing
- Music (both soothing and energizing)
- Sensory and fidget items
- Student's favorite toys and activities
- Weighted blankets
