Describe your pet's general behaviors, personality, and temperament.

Are there particular situations where your pet does not interact well?
Has your pet ever caused any injury to any person, child, or animal?

If you board your pet, please provide details: Who do you board with? Do you send items with them? Are there special instructions?
If you put your pet in a day care, please provide details: What day care do you use? Any special instructions?
Is your pet kept around other animals? If so, is that what the pet prefers?

Does your pet have any favorite activities – ex. swimming, fetching, going for walks or car rides, sitting in front of a window looking out, etc.?
Does your pet have any unique quirks and behavioral issues not previously covered – ex. fears and phobias, flight risk, difficulty to put in a crate, loves country music, won't use the litter box if watched, etc.?
How do you show your pet affection and praise – ex. Belly rubs, cuddling under a blanket, back scratches, cradle like a baby, etc.?
