Review: Reassurance of eternal life derives exclusively through the LIVING word as MANIFESTED and as MESSAGED AND MEASURED to the Apostles.

- I. The Apostles' ecstasy in the logos of life and our fellowship of joy derive from the manifestation of the living word, "The life was manifested and we have seen it . . . and declare unto you . . . that our/your joy might be full" (1:1-4).
- II. The Apostles' ethic in the logic of light and our fellowship of judgment derive from the message and measure of the living word (1:5-10) "This then is the message which we have heard of him and declare unto you that God is light and in him is no darkness" (v.5).

Today: Reassurance of eternal life derives exclusively through the living word as mediated to the Apostles.

- III. The Apostles ensurance in the law of love and our fellowship of justness derive from the mediation of the living word (2:1-6) "And hereby we do know that we know him if we keep his commandments" (v.3).
 - a. Ensurance = to make certain, sure, safe.
 - b. Justness = Acting or being in conformity with what is morally upright or good (i.e. righteous).
 - c. Mediate = To interpose between parties in order to reconcile them.
