Pursuant to Resolution No. 2018-01 adopted on October 2, 2018, the following Civility Code shall govern all proceedings before the Town of Heidelberg Board of Aldermen:

1. All electronic devices, including cell phones, pagers, cameras, and etc. shall be either turned off or otherwise silenced. 2. Prolonged conversations shall be conducted outside Board meeting hall. 3. Whistling, heckling, gesturing, loud conversations, or other disruptive behavior is prohibited. 4. Only those individuals who have signed the speaker list and/or who have been recognized by the Mayor (or Chair) may address comments to the Board. 5. Comments at public hearings shall be limited to the subject being considered by the Board. 6. Comments at Open Forums shall be directed to Town issues. 7. All public comments shall avoid personal attacks and abusive language 8. No person attending a Town Board meeting is to harass, annoy, or otherwise disturb any other person in the room.

Any member of the public whose behavior is disruptive and violates the Town of Heidelberg Civility Code is subject to removal from the Town Board meeting by an officer and such other actions as may be appropriate. PLEASE NOTE: IN ACCORDANCE: Any person who desires to appeal any decision at this meeting will need a record of this proceeding. For this, such person may need to ensure that a verbatim record of such proceeding is made which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
