**Phases of Competition:** Each category accounts for 25% of the contestant's score.

### **Introduction (Not scored)**

- Each contestant will introduce themselves wearing an outfit of their choice in black, gold, or a combination of each color.

### **Private Interview**

- Four-minute interview with panel of at least 3 judges
- You may choose a dress, skirt/top, jumpsuit, pantsuit that is appropriate for interview.


### **Fitness Wear: Teens Only**

- No bling or embellishments
- Bottoms: leggings, tennis-style skirts, or fitness shorts (no booty shorts).
- Tops: sports bra, tanks, fitness shirt
- Contestants will model fitness wear in the pattern shown below.

### **Swimwear: Miss Only**

- One or two-piece swimsuit
- No thong styles permitted
- Contestants will model swimwear in the pattern shown below.



- Contestants will model gowns in the pattern shown below.
- During evening gown competition, contestants will
  - answer one question derived from personal resume.
  - draw one question from the “fishbowl.”

### ***Pageant Day Schedule (Subject to Change)***

- Registration will begin at 9:30 a.m.
  - Once a contestant is registered, you are free to set up in the dressing room.
- 10:00 a.m. - Orientation in the auditorium. (No food or drinks in the auditorium.)
- 10:30 a.m. – Closed rehearsals (Contestants and pageant staff only)
- 12:30 p.m. – 1:00 p.m. – Contestant Lunch in cafeteria
  - Lunch will be provided for contestants only.
  - Please feel free to bring snacks and drinks, but all areas must be cleaned and free of debris before departing. No food or drinks are permitted in the auditorium. There are cafeteria tables outside of the auditorium.
- 1:00 p.m. - Each contestant may have one person assist with preparation for the interview. Name must be provided at registration to ensure admittance to school.
- 2:00 p.m. – Contestant Interviews
- 4:30 p.m. – Doors open to the public.
  - Tickets are \$10 each and can be purchased at registration or at the door before the pageant.
  - CASH only. No credit cards or checks accepted.
- 5:00 p.m. – Pageant begins

\*\*Each contestant is permitted to have one person for assistance in the dressing room prior to interview and prior to stage competition only. Once competition begins, no one other than contestants and pageant staff are permitted into the dressing room. Name must be provided to Director at registration, and their ticket must be purchased at registration.

\*\*There will not be hair/make-up artists provided by the pageant.

### **What if you win?**

1. Winners agree to compete at the Miss WV USA and Miss WV USA state pageant. Date and location TBD.
2. Winners will receive
  - a. Official USA local/regional sash and crown
  - b. \$500 paid toward state entry fee. Payment is provided directly to the Miss WV USA State Director. This fee will not be paid directly to the titleholders, and it is not transferable to others or deferable to the next pageant year.
  - c. Gift certificate toward state competition attire from Oliverio's of Clarksburg.
  - d. Additional prizes may be awarded based upon secured sponsorships.
3. Winners are requested to make appearances leading up to the state pageant.
  - a. Any activity or appearance that will include wearing of the sash and crown or associates the title with it must be approved by the Director.
  - b. All Teen appearances must be chaperoned by a parent, guardian, or trusted adult.
  - c. Titleholders must be neat in appearance and appropriately dressed when representing their title.
4. You are permitted to compete in other pageants as long as the pageant does not require you to relinquish this title and/or prohibit you from competing in the state WV USA pageant.
5. Titleholders and parent/guardian will be asked to sign a statement of understanding regarding rules and expectations.

\*\*Contestants not selected as the titleholders will receive \$200 toward entry to Miss WV USA and Miss WV Teen USA Pageant. Payments are remitted to the Miss WV USA State Director and have no cash value.
