Extracurricular Event Descriptions

Theory Exam

Students complete weekly written theory assignments and ear training drills in preparation to take the MSTMA theory exam, a written test given in March. There are 12 different levels and students are placed according to age, length of study, etc. Fee: \$30 per level (includes registration plus workbook)

Music Achievement Award
